

EXHIBIT SPACES

5. Spaces measure approximately 10' x 12' for each exhibitor, some spaces are on the sidewalk and others in open areas. If you are requesting space next to another exhibitor, this must appear on applications.
6. Participants are required to provide their own display, sturdy enough to withstand crowds, wind and weather conditions, and must be securely weighted down. Please be prepared for uneven ground. Since the show is held outdoors, electricity cannot be provided.
7. Each exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property in the event of loss, damage or personal injury, and is asked to keep his/her space clean. **Smoking is strongly discouraged as it interferes with the public enjoyment of the show.**
8. Artists are encouraged to work on projects during the show, it adds to the show's atmosphere.

FEES/SALES TAX

9. To do business in Maine, exhibitors must have a currently valid Maine Sales Tax number.
